

CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
JANUARY 9, 1990

The City Council for the City of Crosslake met in a Special Council Session on Tuesday, January 9, 1990 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Roger A. Burshem and Charles O. Miller. Absent were Councilmembers Diana A. Gallaway and Lyle Arends. Also present were Armond Gease and Jean-Paul Hudon from the Planning and Zoning Commission, City Clerk Arlene A. Buchite and one resident.

Mayor Anderson called this meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. stating that the primary purpose of this meeting was to continue the review of the Planning and Zoning Ordinances.

Mayor Anderson had several forms which are used by Crow Wing County and which he said he would like to have used in Crosslake by Spring. Mayor Anderson said there will be check-off places on the forms for the Coordinator to use to show distances from the water and other things have been checked.

A resident present said he has heard that there will be a well permit required from the state and will cost \$50.

Councilmember Burshem said the major concern should be septic systems. Mr. Burshem said he thinks the code book looks pretty good but needs to be followed more closely.

It was the consensus of the Council present that written guidelines for the Coordinator should be set up so he knows exactly what the Council expects him to do for a permit. There should be a accurate drawing of the property showing where the building is to be located, where the well will be located, where the septic system is located and all other pertinent information. The form should also be signed by the person seeking the permit so if the drawing is not followed or if the house is located too close to the water, they can be held accountable.

Mayor Anderson said he would like to have the Council adopt the Comprehensive Plan, the Floodplain Ordinance, the Shoreland Management Ordinance and set parameters for the Coordinator as quickly as this can all be done.
