

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
Crosslake, Minnesota
PUBLIC HEARING - January 17, 1984

The City of Crosslake, Minnesota held a public hearing on January 17, 1984 at 4:30 p.m. in the Council Room of the Municipal Building. The following members were present: Councilman Allen, Anderson, Arends, Nelson and Mayor Bieber. Present also was Ms. Sandy Justin from Region 5. There were no members present from the community.

Mayor Bieber called the public hearing on the Crosslake Road Improvements Project for a Minnesota Small Cities Development Program Application presentation.

The Council directed questions towards Ms. Justin who established the applications ground work for the City, in regards to the engineering costs of such project. Was explained that these were already figured into the application request for grant monies.

Also questioned was the management plan for such grant if this project would meet approval. Was explained that the management costs of such grant is figured already into the grant request and that it has been discussed that Region 5, who has the staff capable of admistering such a grant, would take over the management plan with Council approval and also with the Council having the ultimate responsibility and charge of such project. This is all presented and cost estimated in the project application under Item 25. Management Plan.

The resolution for sponsorship was introduced and the Council was instructed that this resolution would need to be adopted by the Council for submission of such grant application.

Upon no further questions or comments being placed regarding such grant application Mayor Bieber called for adjournment of such public hearing.
