

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
Crosslake, Minnesota  
SPECIAL SESSION B - January 17, 1984

The City of Crosslake, Minnesota met in a second special session on January 17, 1984 at 4:45 p.m. in the Council Room of the Municipal Building. The following members were present: Councilman Allen, Anderson, Arends, Nelson and Mayor Bieber. Present also was Ms. Sandy Justin of Region 5. No members of the community were present.

Mayor Bieber called the meeting to order in regards to Councils resolution to accept or reject the submission of such application for a Small Cities Grant Program for the Road Improvements Project.

MOTION NO. 1SB-01-84 was introduced by Councilman Nelson that we adopt the resolution, Item 27, Resolution of Sponsorship for submission of grant application. SECONDED BY Councilman Arends.

Upon roll call vote being taken all members of the council voted in favor of said motion and Mayor Bieber declared the motion carried.

Discussion was placed towards the submitting of such application by mail or in person. Was explained that such application required submission by February 1 and that Mr. Clark Arneson, Region 5 would be going down on the 30th of January and would be submitting other grants and would also submit Crosslake's if Council would wish. Was the Council's feelings that an in person handling of the application would be best and most certain receipt of such application.


