

January 24, 1975

The Crosslake City Council met in regular session on January 24, 1975 at the Crosslake Game & Fish Building. Mayor Fogelberg called the session to order at 7:35 P.M. Present were Councilmen Olson, Andolshek, Foss and Clerk Perkins. Several visitors were also in attendance.

The minutes of the January 15th meeting were considered and the following changes recommended:

Clerk Perkins requested to be allowed to change the last sentence of paragraph 2, page 1, to read, "Councilwoman Andolshek moved, with second by Peterson, that the minutes of Dec. 13th and Dec. 20th be accepted as amended."

Councilman Foss moved, with second by Olson, to change the last sentence of paragraph 4, page 2, to read, "His salary to remain unchanged in the interim." Motion Carried.

Councilman Foss then moved, with second by Olson, to accept the minutes of the January 15th meeting as amended. All voting aye.

Councilman Olson moved, with second by Andolshek, to allow William Schliek and John Wicklund to be put to work supervising the City ice rink. Their salaries are paid thru Minn. CEP Title VI funds and their schedules are to be arranged with the Clerk. All voting aye.

Police Chief Backdahl reported that Luke Gallagher has been scheduled for BCA School in Arden Hills starting March 17th. His probationary period, satisfactorily completed, will end on March 3rd, so Councilman Foss moved, with second by Councilwoman Andolshek, that the Clerk make arrangements for his attendance. The Clerk reported the approximate cost breakdown for the eight week period, not including salary, to be:

An auto accident prevented Mr. Milton Roppe of the Army Corps of Engineers being present to discuss the proposed campground expansion. Mayor Fogelberg reported he will be present at the February 14th meeting to discuss the matter.

Councilman Foss asked to be replaced on the Road Commission. Mayor Fogelberg appointed Councilman Olson to replace Foss.

Councilman Peterson was selected to fill the third position on the Health Inspectors commission.


Councilman Foss was asked to continue to represent the City on the Regional Council, which he agreed to do. Councilman Olson so moved, with second by Andolshek. All voted aye with Foss abstaining.

Mr. Jack Vigoren, attorney from Nisswa, attended the meeting. Mr. Vigoren had been asked to consider the position of City Attorney and had consented so to do for a fee of \$30.00 per meeting attended plus mileage to and from meetings. He would be paid additionally for time spent outside meetings on City business.

Mr. Vigoren discussed the City Attorney's position in regard to collection of bad checks issued in the City. Any check under \$100.00 is considered to be a City problem, not a County Attorney problem. Several sides of the problem were discussed, such as cost incurred to the City, responsibility of the individual business and the actual magnitude of the problem in Crosslake. Councilman Foss agreed to canvas the area merchants as to the degree of problem and report his findings to the Council.

Tom Douglas was present as a representative of Minn. CEP. He discussed the program and informed the Council of the availability of funds to hire many types of workers for the City. He encouraged the City to explore areas of need and take full advantage of the program to provide local employment in this time of high local un-employment.

Councilman Olson moved, with second by Andolshek, to adjourn the meeting at 8:40 P.M. Carried.
