

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
FEBRUARY 5, 1996
7:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake, Minnesota held a joint session with the Public Works Commission in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, February 5, 1996. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor David Kolesar, Jane Michaud, Charles Miller, Raymond Smyth and Jack Webster. The following Public Works Commission members were present: Mark Pearson, Dean Swanson, Richard Koch, John Moengen, Roy Dolmar and Public Works foreman Pat Hoag. Present from Widseth Smith Nolting and Associates, the appointed City Engineering Firm was Darrell Schneider, Sr. and Bill Cheney. Also present was City Clerk Arlene Buchite and approximately 10 Citizens. Christine Dufore, a reporter from the Brainerd Dispatch was also present.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Kolesar at 7:00 p.m. Mayor Kolesar then turned the meeting over to Darrell Schneider.

Mr. Schneider explained the assessment policy with an overhead slide presentation. Crosslake has approximately 70 miles of roads of which the City takes care of approximately 41 miles with the rest being County roads. The Engineers estimated improvements costs for City roads at \$2,326,396 for new pavement, \$1,058,436 for maintenance on currently paved roads for an overall total cost of \$3,384,832.
