

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CROSSLAKE, MINNESOTA
SPECIAL SESSION - February 14, 1987
9:00 a.m. at City Hall

The City Council of Crosslake, Minnesota met in a special session on Saturday, February 14, 1987 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following members were present: Mayor Oliver Courts and Councilmembers Elizabeth Andolshek, Lyle Arends and Diana Gallaway. Councilman Oliver Yates was absent.
