

February 24, 1975

The duly called special session of the Crosslake City Council was called to order at 10:00A.M. at City Hall by Mayor Fogelberg. Present were Councilmen Peterson, Andolshek, Olson and Clerk Perkins.

Councilwoman Andolshek moved, with second by Peterson, to approve preparation and submission of the Preapplication for Federal Assistance Part I, further that Mayor Orena Fogelberg be authorized to sign all necessary documents for the project. All voting aye.

Clerk Perkins indicated that after talking to Region V representatives, it was found necessary for the City to adopt the resolution for "Land Use and Control Measurements in Flood Plain Areas". The City would in addition need to apply for inclusion in the National Flood Insurance Program before the City would qualify for federal funds.

Councilman Peterson moved, with second by Olson, that we pursue the necessary action to comply with these regulations. All voting aye.

Councilman Olson moved, with second by Peterson, that Andolshek be authorized to explore the Zenith number for police calls to the Sheriff's office. She is to meet with the Crow Wing County Commissioners on Wednesday, February 26th to determine the details of the program. She will report at the February 28th meeting, her findings. All voting aye.

Councilman Olson moved that Doris Shafer work only on Saturdays in the City Hall office. No vote was called, however, it seemed to be agreed this should be the case. Clerk Perkins indicated he would do so, however, this may not be practical in many instances.

Councilwoman Andolshek moved, with second by Olson, that the meeting stand adjourned. Carried.
