The duly called special session of the Crosslake City Council was called to order by Mayor Fogelberg at 2:00 P.M. at City Hall. Present were Councilmen Peterson, Andolshek, Olson and Clerk Perkins. Councilman Foss was absent due to the Clerk not notifying him of the meeting time. The Clerk expresses his apology to the Council and Mr. Foss for this error.

Councilman Olson moved, with second by Andolshek, to allow Brainerd Dodge to withdraw their bid for the squad car after receiving a letter from them stating, "Due to a miscalculation of figures, I would like to withdraw my bid on the Crosslake Police Car." All voting aye.

Councilman Olson then moved to accept the \$4789.93 bid from Tanner Motors for a Plymouth Fury. Andolshek seconded the motion and all members voted aye.

Councilman Peterson moved, with second by Andolshek, to appoint Norman Noring and Andy Holzer to serve on the Road Commission. All voting aye.

Councilman Olson moved, with second by Peterson, that the March 28th meeting be canceled due to its falling on Good Friday and there being no pressing business. All voting aye.
