

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
Crosslake, Minnesota  
SPECIAL SESSION - March 31, 1986

The City Council of Crosslake, Minnesota met in a special session on March 31, 1986 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following members were present: Mayor August Mezzenga, Councilman Robert Allen and Oliver Courts. Councilman Nelson and Yates were absent. Also present were the following Planning and Zoning Commission members: Chairman Glenn Bennett, Jay Andolshek, Lyle Arends, Roy Schafer and Don Thomas.

Mayor Mezzenga called the meeting to order at approximately 9:30 a.m. for the purpose of selecting a temporary Planning and Zoning Coordinator during the illness and absence of Marlowe Kingstedt.

MOTION NO. 3S-01-86 WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN ALLEN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN COURTS TO APPOINT ALEC DONALDSON AS TEMPORARY PLANNING AND ZONING COORDINATOR. Don Thomas requested that Lyle Arends be made the temporary coordinator. Discussion ensued. Council members said they felt it could be a conflict of interest since Arends is in the excavating and septic installation business and since Mr. Donaldson was the previous Coordinator, he was familiar with City policies and procedures. Therefore, all Council members present voted in favor of said motion. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
