

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
APRIL 12, 1991

The City Council for the City of Crosslake Minnesota met in a Special Session on Friday, April 12, 1991 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Roger A. Burslem, Charles O. Miller and Dean L. Swanson. Also present were City Attorney James M. Gammello, Police Chief John W. Backdahl and City Clerk Arlene A. Buchite. There were no citizens present.

Mayor Anderson called this special meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. stating that the primary purpose of this meeting was to discuss with the City Attorney the threatened lawsuit against a Police Officer of the City and also the accusations against the Police Chief. MOTION NO. 4S-01-91 WAS MADE BY MEMBER ARENDS AND SECONDED BY MEMBER MILLER TO CLOSE THE MEETING BECAUSE OF THE NOTICE OF INTENT AND THE PERSONNEL ISSUES. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO 4S-02-91 WAS MADE BY MAYOR ANDERSON AND SECONDED BY MEMBER SWANSON TO GIVE A VOTE OF CONFIDENCE TO THE POLICE CHIEF. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 4S-03-91 WAS MADE BY MEMBER SWANSON AND SECONDED BY MEMBER MILLER TO ADJOURN THIS SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION AT 4:41 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
