

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
APRIL 21, 1995
1:30 P.M. AT CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake met in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Friday, April 21, 1995. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Dave Kolesar, Jane Michaud, Chuck Miller and Jack Webster. Absent was Ray Smyth. Also present was City Clerk Arlene Buchite and Reporter Jean Paul Hudon. There were no residents present.

Mayor Kolesar called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m. stating that the first item of business would be to approve the transfer of the beer and wine licences at Ox Lake Tavern. Clerk Buchite indicated that the police had checked out the applications and everything was fine. MOTION NO. 453-01-95 WAS MADE BY CHUCK MILLER AND SECONDED BY JACK WEBSTER TO APPROVE THE TRANSFER OF THE OX LAKE TAVERN FROM AHHP COPT, TO TRACY HENDERSON AND SCOTT CORDAHL. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

The police contract with Mission was discussed briefly. Mission Town Board had accepted the offer made by Mayor Kolesar and Police Chief Backdahl. MOTION NO. 453-02-95 WAS MADE BY JANE MICHAUD AND SECONDED BY JACK WEBSTER TO APPROVE THE POLICE CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CROSSLAKE AND MISSION TOWNSHIP. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mayor Kolesar stated that there were a list of items that would need to be purchased, one was an additional squad car. Mayor Kolesar indicated that because of the new squad at this time it should add more time between replacing the squads from now on. MOTION NO. 453-03-95 WAS MADE BY CHUCK MILLER AND SECONDED BY JANE MICHAUD TO PURCHASE A NEW POLICE CAR. Ms. Michaud told the Council that the money for Cops Fast should be coming to the City very soon. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Council was informed that there will be a continued closed session for Union Contract salaries and benefits on Friday, April 28, 1995 at the Emergency Services Center.

MOTION NO. 453-04-95 WAS MADE BY CHUCK MILLER AND SECONDED BY JACK WEBSTER TO ADJOURN THIS SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING AT 1:39 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
