

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
MONDAY APRIL 26, 1993
7:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake met in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Monday, April 26, 1993. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Charles D. Miller, Dean L. Swanson and John R. Webster. Also present was Vicki Cook from the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, Zoning Coordinator Teri Hastings and approximately 45 residents.

Mayor Anderson called this Public Hearing to order at 7:00 p.m. stating that the first item on the agenda would be to approve letting the Telephone Company advertise for an installer repairman rather than a ground worker. Marty Heino, Telephone Company Plant Manager stated that a more qualified person could do more jobs and would fill in better because of the resignation of the General Manager. MOTION NO. 4S-01-93 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY J. WEBSTER TO APPROVE THE ADVERTISING FOR AN INSTALLER REPAIRMAN FOR THE TELEPHONE COMPANY. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 4S-02-93 WAS MADE BY L. ARENDS AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO RELEASE \$41,800.00 WHICH THE CITY HAS BEEN HOLDING, TO THE LION'S CLUB TO BUILD A REST STOP/INFORMATION BUILDING. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 4S-03-93 WAS MADE BY J. WEBSTER AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO RELEASE \$2,000.00 TO THE BASEBALL ASSOCIATION SO THEY CAN OPEN A CHECKING ACCOUNT TO PAY SMALL BILLS AND TO KEEP ALL RECEIPTS TO TURN OVER TO THE CITY CLERK. MOTION PASSED WITH L. ARENDS VOTING NAY.

Mayor Anderson left the meeting at this time. Acting Mayor L. Arends took over as Chair.

Victoria Cook from Minnesota Pollution Control Agency was next on the agenda. She spoke on "The Individual Onsite Wastewater Treatment Systems Grant Program" which has been approved for the GoodrichLake, D'Brian Lake and Velvet Lake areas. Many questions and concerns were addressed.

MOTION NO. 4S-04-93 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO ADJOURN THIS PUBLIC HEARING AT 8:50 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
