

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION - April 30, 1987
7:00 p.m. at City Hall

The City Council of Crosslake Minnesota met in a special session on Thursday April 30, 1987 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following members were present: Mayor Oliver Courts and Councilmembers Elizabeth Andolshek, Lyle Arends, Diana Gallaway and Oliver Yates. Also present were Road Commission members.

Mayor Courts called this special meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and indicated the primary purpose of this meeting was to open and review bids for purchasing a used road grader. Mayor Courts stated to those present that the City has a right to reject any and all bids.
