

May 6, 1975

This duly called special session of the Crosslake City Council was called to order by Mayor Fogelberg at 2:00 P.M. Present were Councilmen Foss, Peterson, Olson, Andolshek, Clerk Perkins, City Attorney Vigoren, Mr. Mike Hammergren and Donald Paster.

Mr. Paster had come to discuss details of the purchase of his mother's property by the City. Following a lengthy exchange of ideas, it was agreed that Mr. Paster would now prepare an offer for the City to consider and send it to Mr. Vigoren.

It appears that Big Pine Realty does not intend to remove the office building from the Echo Ridge property as they have been instructed to do. The Clerk was instructed to prepare a letter for Mr. Backstrom to sign, ordering the immediate removal of the building. Mr. Vigoren is to read the letter before it is sent.

Telephone service is to be provided to Big Pine Realty as requested with a letter informing them that they are liable for all costs if forced to move in the near future.

Councilman Peterson moved for the adoption of the following resolution,

Contingent upon the required funds from DHUD, be it hereby resolved,

That the City of Crosslake, Minnesota will commit 20 acres of the property presently under negotiation for purchase, which property is described as follows: located in Section 9, Township 137, Range 27,

That said property is to be used for the multi-purpose community center,

And, that the City of Crosslake will commit the sum of \$16,000.00 to acquisition of said property and its development.


Councilman Foss seconded the above motion. The vote of the Council was as follows:


