

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
BOARD OF REVIEW MEETING
WEDNESDAY, MAY 6, 1992
9:30 A.M. AT CITY HALL

The City Council for the City of Crosslake met in a Board of Review Meeting with the County Assessor's Office on Wednesday, May 6, 1992 in the Council Chambers of City Hall.

Council Members present were Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Charles O. Miller and Dean L. Swanson. Councilmember Roger A. Burhsem was in the building but did not sit in on the Board of Review hearings. Present from the Assessor's Office were Assessor Martyn Schmidt, Deputy Assessor Patricia Dechaine and Darrell Olson. Approximately 51 residents were present.

Mayor Anderson called this meeting to order and then turned the meeting over to Mr. Schmidt. Mr. Schmidt informed those present that this meeting was for the residents who had been notified that their property taxes were going to be increased. Mr. Schmidt then explained the taxing structure and that the State of Minnesota properties are taxed by the avalorum taxing system. This means that the majority of properties should sell between 90% and 110% of the market value as stated on the County Tax Statement or the State of Minnesota will demand an increase for all like properties.

Mr. Schmidt explained the review process for any property owner who wanted to have his property reassessed.

All property owners present who wished to be heard were heard. The Assessor's Office will respond to all written inquiries.

Acting Mayor Lyle Arends adjourned this meeting at 12:53 p.m.
