

May 9, 1975

The regular session of the Crosslake City Council was called to order at 7:30 PM by Mayor Fogelberg. Present were Councilmen Foss, Andolshek Petersen, Olson, City Attorney Vigoren, Clerk Perkins and Zoning Coordinator Backstrom.

Foss moved, with a second by Petersen, to accept the minutes of the April 25th and May 6th meetings as written. Motion carried.

Councilwoman Andolshek presented the following requests for action from the Telephone Commission:

Advertise for bids on labor to bury cable from Perkin's corner to the South side of Big Pine Lake and hang aerial cable from the C. O. to Crosslake Store.

Purchase needed cable from Dakota Electric for the above project. Indicated the approximate figure of \$3,500.00.

Councilman Olson moved we purchase the cable from Dakota Electric and advertise for the labor bids when specifications are available. The Clerk is also to explore the possibility of an additional warrant to cover such expense. Petersen seconded the motion and all voted "Aye".

The Council approved the use of available cable and phones, for an emergency, to set up a control center at the City Hall or at the Fire Station

Mr Fauglid of the Pine River State Bank, appealed the Planning Commissions denial of a sign permit. The Council apologized for some misunderstanding on the matter, however, upheld the decision and suggested the Bank find another location for the sign.

Allen McSherry, of Big Pine Realty, approached the Council and asked to temporarily continue use of the office located on the Echo Ridge property. The Council directed Mr McSherry back to the Planning Commission to discuss a possible permit.

Donald Paster submitted a counter offer to the Council. Attorney Vigoren indicated it much to restrictive. Fred Beiber, acting as spokesman for Crosslake Area Assoc., inc. indicated opposition to the proposed use of the property. He submitted a letter from the group to the Clerk to be filed. Attorney Vigoren stated to Mr Paster that the original offer by the City should be considered void. If so desired, the City may make a counter offer to Mr Paster at a later date. No immediate action was taken on the matter. Mr Paster's offer was not considered acceptable.

Francis Fraser, Fire Chief for the Crosslake Volunteer Fire Dept., was present to discuss department procedure and answer Council questions. The Council commended and thanked Mr Fraser and the men for an outstanding bit of community service.

Councilman Foss moved, with second by Petersen, for the Clerk to transfer funds (\$4,000.00) from the Passbook Acct. #8301-6-020954 at the First Federal to the general account of the City. Motion carried.

Olson moved, with second by Andolshek, to accept the City report and pay all bills. Motion carried.

Foss moved, with second by Andolshek, to accept the Telephone Report and pay all bills.
Motion carried.

Councilman Foss again complimented Bill Schliek for the fine work done on the warming house. Foss also commented on the Fund raising for CPR Equipment for the Ambulance. Apparently all but approximately \$250.00 has been raised. Mr Foss also indicated he had contacted Mr Dowdy of the Bequot Lakes School as he had agreed to do. The letter of reply was read and filed with the Clerk.

Councilman Olson moved, with a second by Petersen, to set aside up to \$300.00 to pay the balance due on the CPR Equipment, Motion carried. This unit is to be the property of the city.
