

June 22, 1973

A special meeting of the Crosslake village council was held at 7:30 P.M. in the village hall. Present were Mayor Kluender, Councilmen Foss, Olson, Coulter and Schneider.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Kluender. Councilmen Foss kept minutes of the meeting in absence of clerk Schalow.

It was decided that the clerk write a letter to the St. Paul District Corps. of Army Engineers and ask the terms of a long term lease on the two areas within the village presently under the jurisdiction of the Corps. Areas involved are on Little Pine Lake and on the South Bay of Crosslake. The council would like a long term lease to retain these lands as wildlife areas.

Councilman Foss agreed to undertake a salary survey for all village employees with the thought being to work on the 1974 payroll budget.

Clerk Schalow arrived at 8:10 P.M.

The matter of the possible relocation of the telephone building came up and was discussed briefly. Councilman Schneider moved that the village hall property be surveyed to determine exact location of lot lines. There was a brief discussion of the timing of such a move and councilman Schneider then withdrew his motion until such time as Mr. Armfield determines the size of the building required.

A discussion took place regarding a washout on the village road near the Hilder Foss home. Councilman Foss to contact Lee Foss to make certain the washout is repaired.

It was decided that the July 13th meeting should start at 4:00 P.M. with bids to open for telephone equipment at 8:00 P.M.

Mr. Daniel Jwanouskos asked for permission of the village council to hold a grass dance on the Pastor property on July 4th for the benefit of the Cub and Boy Scouts. On motion of Coulter with second by Olson, permission was granted provided that:

1. Off Street Parking be Provided.
2. Mr. Jwanouskos obtains permission of the property owner
3. County permission is obtained to place the banner across county highway 6.

On motion of Foss and second by Olson, the clerk was ordered to write a letter to Mr. Sterling Hoff to ask for payment of the remaining \$70.00 on the blacktop project for the Happy Landing Road.

On motion of Coulter and second by Foss the meeting adjourned.
