

Crosslake City Council  
July 3, 1979 - Special Meeting  
7:30 PM  
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A special meeting of the City Council was called to order by Mayor Whisler at 7:30 PM. Present were Councilmen Andolshek, Arends, Delmonico and Benson. Gary Fread, Manager of the Telephone Company was present and five members of the community.

The purpose of the meeting was to decide what steps the City of Crosslake should take in view of the pending hearing to establish the eligibility of telephone company employees to vote in joining the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local Union #949, AFL-CIO, of which hearing the Telephone Company had received a formal notice.

Mr. Gary Fread presented the views of the Telephone Commission and the advice of Attorney, Bob Johnson who both recommended that we authorize the hiring of a consultant. Having checked on other firms, the following firm was recommended:

On a motion by Lyle Arends and seconded by Andolshek that the employment of Tim McFeters be terminated and hired back as needed. All members voting "AYE", the motion carried.
