

Crosslake City Council
August 6, 1979 - Special Meeting

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The special meeting of the Crosslake City Council was called to order by Mayor, Charles E. Whisler at 7:00 P.M. The purpose of the meeting was to present and discuss the tentative budget plans for 1980. There were eleven members of the community present.

Mr. Whisler announced that all legal requirements had been met to hold this meeting and read the legal notice appearing in the Brainerd paper.

The list of anticipated receipts and anticipated disbursements were presented by the mayor and each item was discussed by the Council.

The clerk agreed to find out which accounts were included under the City Hall expenses for Benson.

It was suggested by Delmonico that it would be very useful if Arends could present a more detailed budget at the next meeting. The City Clerk agreed to aid Arends in preparing this budget.

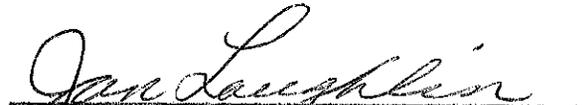
Benson was excused at 8:05 to attend another meeting.
