

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
August 22, 1988
9:00 a.m. at City Hall

The City Council of Crosslake Minnesota met in a special session on Monday, August 22, 1988 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following members were present: Mayor Oliver Courts and Councilmembers Lyle Arends, Diana Gallaway and Dean Swanson. Councilmember Oliver Yates arrived at approximately 9:30 a.m. Also present were Fire Chief David Schlick, Police Chief John Backdahl, Road Supervisor Pat Hoag and City Clerk Arlene Buchite. There were no members of the community present.

Mayor Courts called this meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. stating that the primary purpose of this meeting was to discuss budgets.

Police Chief Backdahl stated that his budget was prepared with a provision for a third full time officer, at the request of one of the Councilmembers. Councilmember Swanson said he felt this should go before the Public Safety Commission before the Council would approve it.

At 10:00 a.m. Mayor Courts asked for the bids that were received for the possible purchase of a loader. Clerk Buchite indicated she had received bids from Ziegler Inc. and Carlson's Lake State Equipment. Mayor Courts opened the bids which were:

1. A 1981 Hough Model 860E from Ziegler, Inc.....\$23,350.00
2. A 1985 Catapillar IT12 with cab heater, a 1.25 yard bucket and new tires from Ziegler Inc..... 39,895.00
3. A 1980 John Deere 544B from Carlson's Lake State Equip..... 32,000.00

Road Supervisor Pat Hoag said he would like to have himself and possibly one or two of the Road Commission members view the machines before the decision is made to purchase one of them. MOTION NO. 8S3-01-88 WAS MADE BY COUNCILMEMBER GALLAWAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER ARENDS TO REFER THE BIDS BACK TO THE ROAD COMMISSION FOR THEIR RECOMMENDATION AND TO HAVE SOMEONE VIEW THE MACHINES. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

All departmental budgets were reviewed with cuts made where it could be cut without hurting any department.

Mayor Courts left the meeting at approximately 4:00 p.m. Acting Mayor Gallaway took over the meeting.

MOTION NO. 8S3-02-88 WAS MADE BY ACTING MAYOR GALLAWAY AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMEMBER SWANSON TO ADJOURN THIS SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION AT 5:20 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
