

August 23, 1973

A duly called special meeting of the Crosslake Village Council was held at 1:00P.M. in the village hall. Purpose of the meeting was to interview candidates for the positions of patrolman and a combination man for the telephone system. Present were Mayor Kluender, Councilmen Coulter, Olson, Foss and Schneider. Clerk Schalow arrived about an hour late.

Thirteen candidates for the position of patrolman were interviewed by the council, including: Mr. Patrick Borman, Tom McCarthy, Darrell Steven Kortan, Thomas Mehr, John Parker, Gary Benjamin (telephone) Bruce Goldenstein, David Bollie, Rick Rowell, Joe Jelen, Stanley Gordon, Donald Hubbard, and Jan Mezzenga, and Jeff Austin.

Five candidates for the position of combination man for the telephone system were interviewed, included in these interviews were: Rick Adair, Duane Pauna, ~~Ken Lehnhoff~~ Jay Andolshek. Two candidates were unable to be present on this date for interviews, and the council agreed to meet with them on Sept. 1, 1973 at noon. These candidates are: Ken Wilson and Rodney Mertens.

On motion of councilman Foss and second by councilman Schneider, Mr. Paul Hoheisel was appointed to the position of working mgr. of the telephone company. Clerk to arrange for publication of this appointment in local newspapers. All members voting aye.

On motion of Foss and second by Olson, Mr. Hoheisel is to submit to the council in writing within the next two months:

1. What views he has as to what changes should be made to make the operation more effective.
2. The order in which they should be made. All members voting aye.

Councilman Foss also recommended that the council make a greater effort to carry on the business at council meetings in a more orderly manner.

After a lengthy discussion between the council members and Chief Backdahl regarding the tentative selection of a patrolman, it was moved by Foss that the council hire Mr. John Parker provided he can pass the physical examination. Clerk to be advised of results of this exam so he can notify other candidates by Sept. 1, 1973 as to councils selection. (Second by Coulter)

Motion by Schneider and second by Olson that the salary of the patrolman be set at \$550.00 per month, and that Mr. Parker start work effective Sept. 1st, 1973, and that a provision of the job be that he give up the part time bartending job he presently has. All members voting aye.

On motion of Olson and second by Schneider the meeting adjourned.
