

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
PUBLIC HEARING
AUGUST 29, 1990

The City Council for the City of Crosslake Minnesota met in a public hearing on Wednesday, August 29, 1990 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Diana A. Gallaway and Charles O. Miller. Councilmember Roger A. Burshem arrived at approximately 7:15. Also present were Department Heads John Backdahl, Patricia Felber, Pat Hoag and City Clerk Arlene Buchite as well as one resident.

Mayor Anderson said the Council would review the other items on the agenda prior to reviewing budgets. Clerk Buchite indicated that election judges were only paid \$3.50 per hour in 1988 and minimum wage is \$3.90 now. MOTION NO. 8PH-01-90 WAS MADE BY MEMBER GALLAWAY AND SECONDED BY MEMBER MILLER TO PAY THE ELECTION JUDGES \$4.00 PER HOUR. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mayor Anderson stated he had gone to the Auditor's Office and was told that the City should submit a large enough levy before September 4, 1990 because the levy request can be lowered but not raised after that date.

MOTION NO. 8PH-02-90 WAS MADE BY MEMBER GALLAWAY AND SECONDED BY MEMBER MILLER TO SUBMIT THE PRELIMINARY LEVY LIMIT OF \$735,000 TO THE COUNTY. MOTION PASSED WITH MEMBERS BURSHEM, GALLAWAY AND MILLER VOTING AYE AND ARENDS VOTING NAY.

MOTION NO. 8PH-03-90 WAS MADE BY MEMBER GALLAWAY AND SECONDED BY MEMBER MILLER TO SET THE TRUTH IN TAXATION CITY BUDGET HEARINGS FOR NOVEMBER 20, 1990 AT 7:00 P.M. AND THE RECONVENE SESSION ON DECEMBER 4, 1990 AT 7:00 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mayor Anderson asked Councilmember Miller to check with Mr. Gottwald to see who would be plowing the post office to determine if some arrangement could be made to alternate plow the front of the building with the City plowing crew.

At this point department budgets were reviewed and some changes were made.

Mayor Anderson suggested that the Road Commission and Department seek information about having Sunrise Island Bridge placed on the list for funding. Mayor Anderson asked Member Miller to check it out.

Mayor Anderson said he spoke to the firemen about the possibility of adding a meeting room and stall onto the fire hall if they would do the majority of the work themselves. Mayor Anderson also discussed the possibility of a stress test for all firemen.

MOTION NO. 8PH-04-90 WAS MADE BY MEMBER GALLAWAY AND SECONDED BY MEMBER MILLER TO ADJOURN THIS PUBLIC HEARING AT 9:25 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
