

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

The Council for the City of Crosslake met in a Special Council Session on Thursday, September 5, 1996 in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following Councilmembers were present Mayor David Kolesar, Charles Miller, Raymond Smyth and Jack Webster. City employees Pat Hoag, Rob Larson and John Backdahl were also present to review their respective department budgets. Also present was City Clerk Arlene Buchite. There were no reporters or citizens present.

Mayor Kolesar called this special meeting to order at approximately 1:44 after the arrival of Mr. Smyth. Mr. Miller arrived a short time later.

Department budgets were reviewed and some changes were made. Cleaning of the Emergency Services Center and the Community Center by companies other than City employees was discussed. Possibly leasing a copy machine was also discussed.

The Cemetery budget was incorporated into the Public Works budget, the City Hall budget was incorporated into the Administration budget and the Ambulance budget was incorporated into the Fire Department budget.

A retirement proposal for the City Clerk using her accumulated sick leave was discussed. MOTION NO. 9S-01-96 WAS MADE BY CHUCK MILLER AND SECONDED BY RAY SMYTH TO APPROVE THE CONCEPT OF THE RETIRMENT PROPOSAL FOR THE CITY CLERK AND TO HAVE THE CITY ATTORNEY DRAW UP A LEGAL DOCUMENT. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
