

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 23, 1991
10:00 A.M. AT CITY HALL

The City Council for the City of Crosslake Minnesota met in a Special Council Session on Monday, September 23, 1991 at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following members were present: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Roger A. Burshem, Dean L. Swanson and Charles O. Miller. Also present were Don Coulter, Shonna Holker, Roy Dolmar, Bill Meyer from Landecker and Associates and City Clerk Arlene A. Buchite.

Mayor Anderson called this meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and stated that the primary purpose of this meeting was to continue to review the proposed planning and zoning ordinances and to hold a personnel meeting at 3:00 p.m. with all City employees.

D. Swanson indicated that he has had numerous complaints regarding the access to Velvet Lake that Del Anderson has put in. He suggested that a three day waiting period may be helpful for the zoning coordinator.

C. Miller said he has had complaints about horses driving bicyclists off the path and requested that this be put on the October Council agenda.

MOTION NO. 992-01-91 WAS MADE BY L. ARENDS AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO BREAK FOR LUNCH. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY AT 12.05 P.M.

Mayor Anderson reconvened this meeting at 1:10 p.m. Reviewing the zoning ordinances continued.

MOTION NO. 992-02-91 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY R. BURSHAM TO TAKE A TEN MINUTE BREAK. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

Mayor Anderson reconvened this meeting at 3:05 p.m.

Discussion ensued regarding having the City Clerk act as purchasing agent for the City. The employees felt that they would rather have things continue as they are at present and do their own ordering. The Clerk also would rather have things continue as they are, because the majority of the time, the department head knows when an item has been received and will fill the purchase order out within a few days.
