

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF CROSSLAKE  
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2009  
2:30 P.M. – CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake met in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, September 30, 2009. The following Council Members were present: Mayor Jay Andolshek, Steve Roe, Rusty Taubert, John Moengen and Dean Swanson. Also present were City Administrator Tom Swenson, Clerk/Treasurer Jenny Max and Community Development Director Ken Anderson.

1. Mayor Andolshek called the Special Meeting to order at 2:30 P.M.
2. MOTION 09S3-01-09 WAS MADE BY DEAN SWANSON AND SECONDED BY JOHN MOENGEN TO APPROVE THE BILLS FOR PAYMENT AS PRESENTED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$49,679.62. MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL AYES.
3. Tom Swenson stated that the proposed AFSCME Union contract has been ratified by the union and council approval of the contract was being recommended by Labor Attorney Steve Fecker and the Personnel Committee. Mr. Swenson noted that the wage increase was 1.00%, 1.50% and 1.75% for years 2009, 2010 and 2011, respectively, and city paid insurance coverage for retired employees was changed to be for three years from the date of retirement without consideration of the employee's age. MOTION 09S3-02-09 WAS MADE BY DEAN SWANSON AND SECONDED BY STEVE ROE TO APPROVE THE CONTRACT SETTLEMENT WITH AFSCME UNION LOCAL #689 CONTINGENT UPON RECEIPT OF THE SIGNED CONTRACT FROM THE UNION AS DRAFTED BY ATTORNEY FECKER. MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL AYES.

MOTION 09S3-03-09 WAS MADE BY JOHN MOENGEN AND SECONDED BY JAY ANDOLSHEK TO ADJOURN THE SPECIAL MEETING AT 2:35 P.M. MOTION CARRIED WITH ALL AYES.
