

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION  
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 1991  
10:00 A.M. AT CITY AHELL

The City Council for the City of Crosslake Minnesota met in a Special Council Session on Monday, September 30, 1991 at 10:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall. The following members were present: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Roger A. Burshem, Dean L. Swanson and Charles O. Miller. Also present were Bill Meyer from Landecker and Associates, Donald Coulter, Shonna Holker, Roy Dolmar, Planning and Zoning Coordinator Teri Daehn and City Clerk Arlene Buchite.

The Comprehensive Plan was discussed briefly. The Planning and Zoning Commission will be working on the update shortly.

Variations were discussed at length. Mr. Meyer indicated that for appeals all property owners notified for the first public hearing must be notified for appeals.

Mayor Anderson called for a lunch break at 12:15 p.m.

Mayor Anderson reconvened this meeting at 1:20 p.m. All Councilmembers were present.

A lengthy discussion ensued regarding commercial property in Crosslake. MOTION NO. 953-01-91 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY L. ARENDS TO HAVE THE COMMERCIAL PROPERTY ALONG HIGHWAY 6 TO THE NORTHERN BORDER OF CROSSLAKE AND ALONG HIGHWAY 3 TO THE SOUTHERN BORDER OF CROSSLAKE AS IT IS AT PRESENT. Discussion regarding waterfront commercial and how far back off the highway the commercial property should go. MOTION PASSED WITH ANDERSON, ARENDS, BURSHEM AND MILLER VOTING AYE. SWANSON VOTED NAY.

MOTION NO. 953-02-91 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY R. BURSHEM TO ADJOURN THIS MEETING AT 2:08 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
