

SPECIAL MEETING

A special meeting of the City Council was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Fogelberg. Oct. 2, 1975.

Present: Councilmen Foss, Olson, Petersen, Police Chief John Backdahl, Mr and Mrs Wickstrom and Mr and Mrs Ketch representing the Fifty Lakes Council.

Absent: Councilwoman Andolshek.

The Councilmen from Fifty Lakes asked as to what Police Protection we would be willing to give them and at what cost? They retired to another room for a conference with Chief Backdahl, returned and reported they would report to their council and report to us what they can pay and what coverage they desire.

Mayor Fogelberg presented the letter of resignation from Clerk Perkins.

Mr Foss reported the follow up of the Audit and all the work to be done on the Telephone books to bring them to date., etc. Councilman Olson asked Doris Shafer if she would accept the position as Clerk. She declined.

Motion by Olson, seconded by Petersen, we accept the resignation of Clerk Perkins as of October 3, 1975.
All voting "AYE". Motion carried.

Motion by Petersen, seconded by Foss, the City pay the entire cost of the lumber for the Hockey Rink, Approximately \$412.00. The City to be reimbursed with the difference of \$62.00 of the \$350.00 donated to the fund, as the funds come in.
All voted "AYE". Motion carried.

Applications for the position of Clerk received in 1974 were reviewed. It was decided to ask Mr Charles Whisler to attend a meeting of the Council for an interview at 3:00 P. M. Friday October 3rd. He to be offered \$700.00 per month for a 6 month trial period. Salary to be reconsidered at that time. Work week to be 40 hrs.

Mr Foss to contact Mr Don Engen as to what audit was required and necessary due to the resignation of Clerk Richard Perkins.

Motion by Petersen, seconded by Olson, to adjourn.
All voting "AYE". Motion carried.
