

October 11, 1974

The regular meeting of the Crosslake City Council was held on October 11, 1974. Mayor Kluend~~er~~ called the session to order at 7:30 P.M. Present were Councilmen Schneider, Foss, Coulter and Olson; Clerk Perkins and Zoning Coordinator Peterson.

A motion by Councilman Coulter to accept the minutes for September 13, 17, 28 & October 1 & 8, 1974 was seconded by Foss. All members voting aye.

Al Peterson presented the Planning Commission report which covered the following:

A plat submitted by Anderson Bros. was rejected on the grounds that an outlet was being used to avoid building and blacktopping a needed road on the plat. Council supported the action without motion.

The Commission recommended approval of a Real Estate office next to the Exchange property to be built by the Northgate Company. The Council approved same without a motion.

A motion by Councilman Coulter and second by Schneider approved the dredging permit for Donald Bogdanovich at COOPER'S COVE. All members voting aye. Clerk is to complete form and return to DNR.

A motion by Councilman Olson and second by Schneider approved the request by Bill Reed to make an addition to the rear of his store building. All members voting aye.

Councilman Coulter presented the preliminary plat of BRIARWOOD (Jack Felber property). A motion by Schneider and second by Olson approved the preliminary plat. All Members voting aye.

Councilman Coulter questioned the amount of Bond for City Clerk, which had been set at \$1000.00. The Clerk is to check this and report to the Council. It was also requested the Revenue Sharing statement be specifically labeled in future reports. A question was raised as to why we have savings in the form of C.D.'s and First Federal Accounts. The Clerk was to check and report to Council.

A motion by Councilman Foss, to accept the City report and pay all bills represented by checks #1913 thru 1952, was seconded by Olson. All members voting aye.

Don Coulter suggested there was a need to seal the concrete floors in the City garage and also give a second coat of paint on the inside of the garage doors. Councilman Olson moved, with second by Schneider, that this work be done immediately by the City maintenance man. Motion Carried.

Harold Schneider indicated the telephone men would be made available during the winter months to assist where needed on City maintenance work.

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The Clerk was requested to prepare, at year's end, a breakdown of gasoline usage by each department and prepare a report of same for the City Council.

Councilman Coulter moved, with second by Schneider, that Pat DeZellar be allowed to transfer Graves E, F, G & H, Lot 3, Block 15, To Donald O. Hauser. Motion was carried.

Councilman Foss requested a notice be placed in the Crosslake Shopper as to the new City Clerk, new office hours and voter registration at City Hall.

Councilman Foss moved, with second by Coulter, to establish individual personnel records for all City and Telephone employees. Motion carried.

Councilman Foss indicated a need for activity on the part of the previously appointed Telephone Committee to eliminate much time spent in Council meetings conducting telephone business.

Councilman Schneider mentioned that a letter would be printed in the Crosslake Shopper urging support for the Telephone Bond Issue to be voted upon at the November election.

A motion by Foss to adjourn was seconded by Olson. Motion carried. Meeting was concluded at 9:30 P.M.
