

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
Crosslake, Minnesota
SPECIAL SESSION - November 5, 1985

The City Council of Crosslake and the Crosslake Telephone Commission met in a special session on November 5, 1985 in the Telephone Company Building. Those members of the Council present were: Mayor August Mezzenga, Councilmen Robert Allen, Oliver Courts, Orval Nelson and Oliver Yates. Those members of the Telephone Commission present were: Chairman Libby Andolscheck, Robert Turner, Dene Carney, Scott Henderson and Douglas Nelson. Also present were Helen Fraser, Anthony Mayer and Marv Totland, General Field Representative f REA.

Mayor Mezzenga called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

The Telephone Commission presented the City Council members a list with two recommended options on it for the General Manager's salary increase. The Telephone Commission Chairman informed the Council that their recommendation was the Plan I option.


Discussion ensued with some of the Council members saying that they felt a substantial increase in wages was due but the amount in the proposed option was an 18 percent increase while other City employees received only a 4 percent to 5 percent increase in wages.

The Telephone Commission made a motion to modify their recommendation by requesting a raise from the present \$31,500 a year to \$36,000 a year for the Telephone Manager instead of \$37,300 as in their first recommendation.
