The Crosslake City Council met in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Thursday, November 5, 1992 as the canvassing board for the City election on November 3, 1992. Present were Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Charles O. Miller and Dean L. Swanson. There were no residents present.

Mayor Anderson called this meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

MOTION NO. 115-01-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO VERIFY KURT ANDERSON MAYOR WITH 691 VOTES. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 115-02-91 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO VERIFY 234 VOTES FOR ROGER BURSHEM, 598 VOTES FOR CHARLES MILLER AND 679 VOTES FOR JOHN WEBSTER AND TO DECLARE CHARLES MILLER AND JOHN WEBSTER AS THE WINNERS OF THE TWO COUNCIL SEATS AVAILABLE. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 115-03-92 WAS MADE BY K. ANDERSON AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO ADJOURN THIS MEETING AT 9:35 A.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
