

November 10, 1975

A joint meeting of the City Council and the Telephone Commission was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Mayor Fogelberg. Present were the Mayor, Council members Foss, Andolshek, Peterson and Olson; Clerk Whisler; Telephone Commission members Fraser, Schalow, Anderson and Jay Andolshek. Also in attendance was telephone worker, Ron Schmidt, Rod Mertens being on vacation; John Baxter and Jerry Cook representing REA.

Lillian Wendt appeared before the Council seeking a permit to move an office building of approximately 496 square feet to Gov't. Lot #4. Councilman Olson made a motion, seconded by Peterson that the permit be denied. After a lengthy discussion Olson withdrew his motion. Councilman Olson suggested that Ms. Wendt sign a statement to the effect that she would comply with the requirements of the Planning Commission by July of 1976 or she would remove the building or have the City remove it at her expense. Peterson moved, second by Olson that the Council grant the permit contingent upon the acceptance by the Planning Commission of Ms. Wendt's plans for the building. All voted "AYE".

Mayor Fogelberg turned the gavel over to Telephone Commission Chairwoman Andolshek.

John Baxter and Jerry Cook conducted a lengthy discussion on the possibility of an REA loan. More details on the discussion will be found in the minutes of the Telephone Commission.

Councilman Andolshek mentioned that Father Foster wished to purchase a telephone pole so that he could have a security light setup on the church grounds. After a discussion a price of \$20.00 for the pole was arrived at.

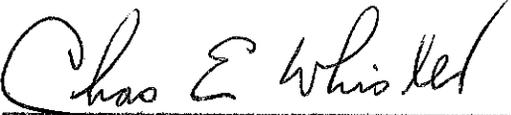
At 10:37 P.M. the telephone personnel left and the City Council remained in session to discuss some requests for building permits.

Dean Eggena's request for permission to erect a building on SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the Sw $\frac{1}{4}$ of Gov't. Lot #2, Sec 9 was held in abeyance until additional information could be obtained concerning the exterior of the building, the parking facilities, the nature of the business, the names of the owners and the expected date of completion. The matter was referred back to the Planning Commission.

The request by Sam Dunbar for permission to build a 28 X 30 Beauty Shop was granted by unanimous consent of the Council.

The request of Rean Kloostra to erect a 36 X 65 storage building on his property was granted by unanimous vote of the Council.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:10 P.M.
