

Crosslake City Council  
November 16, 1982 - 4:00 PM - SPECIAL MEETING - HIRING OF TELEPHONE  
COMPANY MANAGER

The special meeting was called to order by Mayor Carol Coulter at 3:59 PM. Council members present were Coulter, Anderson, Andolshek and Arends. Councilman Delmonico was not able to attend. Telephone Commission members present were Bob Allen, Fred Bieber and Helen Fraser.

Council Liason Arends read the proposed salary and benefits recommended by the Telephone Commission for the hiring of Mr. Anthony Mayer of Deerbrook, Wisconsin as listed in the attached resolution.

Mr. Bieber and Mrs. Fraser both spoke in regard to why they felt this party was well qualified to fill the position and how they arrived at the salary being offered.

MOTION: By Anderson and seconded by Arends to adopt the resolution as presented and recommended by the Telephone Commission for the hiring of Anthony Mayer as Manager of the Telephone Company. The motion carried with all present voting unanimously. The starting date will be January 1, 1983.

Anderson stated that he hopes there will be no trouble with obtaining salary increases for the new manager as he had to fight with the council for increases for the former manager when he was on the Telephone Commission. The mayor asked if he would like to make a motion in regard to salary increases but he stated that this was up to the Telephone Commission for recommendation and he hoped that this new council would back the Commission up. Arends stated that his starting salary will be for one year.

MOTION: By Anderson and seconded by Andolshek that the mayor be authorized to sign the annual engagement letter with the City Auditor, Don Engen, CPA, in the amount of \$1,765. the same as last year. The motion carried and the vote was unanimous.

MOTION: By Anderson and seconded by Arends that the meeting be adjourned. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 4:07 PM.
