

COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS  
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA  
TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING  
THURSDAY, DECEMBER 10, 1992  
7:00 P.M. AT CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake Minnesota met in the Council Chambers of City Hall on Thursday, December 10, 1992 for the purpose of adopting proposed budgets and setting the tax levy for 1993. Present were the following Councilmembers: Mayor Kurt E. Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Dean L. Swanson and John R. Webster. Charles O. Miller arrived at approximately 7:30 p.m. Also present was the City Clerk, approximately 5 residents and the local reporter.

Mayor Anderson called this meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mayor Anderson read four letters received from residents. One of the residents present stated that their only reason for coming to the meeting was because they thought a representative from the County and School Board would be present.

Mayor Anderson briefly explained to those present that he has been conferring with Juran and Moody, Inc. about the possibility of the city selling them the new fire hall and then the city would lease it back and own it after approximately 20 years.

A discussion ensued regarding proposed increases in Firemen's services and the City contribution to the Firemen's Relief Association. MOTION NO. 1291-01-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT BUDGET AT \$109,583 BUT TO FREEZE THE FIREMEN'S SERVICES AND FIREMEN'S RELIEF ASSOCIATION PAY AT THE 1992 LEVEL UNTIL FURTHER REVIEW AND TO CHANGE THE CAPITOL OUTLAY FOR NEW FIREHALL TO \$30,000. MOTION PASSED WITH L. ARENDS VOTING NAY.

MOTION NO. 1291-02-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE ADMINISTRATION BUDGET AT \$94,211. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 1291-03-92 WAS MADE BY J. WEBSTER AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO APPROVE THE POLICE BUDGET AT \$122,317. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 1291-04-92 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY J. WEBSTER TO APPROVE THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT BUDGET AT \$141,302. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 1291-05-92 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY L. ARENDS TO APPROVE THE PLANNING AND ZONING BUDGET AT \$35,904. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-06-92 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO APPROVE THE PARK AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT BUDGET AT \$86,000. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-07-92 WAS MADE BY L. ARENDS AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO APPROVE THE CITY HALL BUDGET AT \$6,050. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-08-92 WAS MADE BY L. ARENDS AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE CEMETERY BUDGET AT \$2,700. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-09-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY L. ARENDS TO APPROVE THE POLICE PERA BUDGET AT \$9,642. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-10-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE AMBULANCE BUDGET AT \$14,061. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-11-92 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO APPROVE THE COMMISSIONS BUDGET AT \$300 AND THE RECYCLING BUDGET AT \$1,700. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-12-92 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY D. SWANSON TO APPROVE THE GOVERNMENT OBLIGATION BONDS REVENUE BUDGET AT \$75,494 AND EXPENSES AT \$83,452. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-13-92 WAS MADE BY L. ARENDS AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE CAPITOL IMPROVEMENT FUND REVENUE BUDGET AT \$3,770 AND EXPENSES AT \$0. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-14-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE TAX INCREMENT FINANCE BUDGET AT \$25,000 FOR PROPOSED REVENUE AND EXPENSES. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-15-92 WAS MADE BY D. SWANSON AND SECONDED BY C. MILLER TO APPROVE THE GENERAL LEVY AT \$397,749 LESS \$696 TAX INCREMENT FINANCE EXCESS RECEIVED PLUS \$57,919 GOVERNMENT OBLIGATION BONDS LEVY. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOTION NO. 12S1-16-92 WAS MADE BY C. MILLER AND SECONDED BY J. WEBSTER TO ADJOURN THIS TRUTH IN TAXATION MEETING AT 8:17 P.M. MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
