

TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING  
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA  
DECEMBER 14, 1994  
7:00 P.M. CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake, Minnesota met in the Chambers of City Hall on Wednesday, December 14, 1994. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Kurt Anderson, Chuck Miller, Dean Swanson and Jack Webster. Absent was Lyle Arends. Also present was City Clerk Arlene Buchite and approximately 8 citizens.

Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. and stated the purpose of the meeting was to hold the 1994 Truth and Taxation Hearing.

Mayor Anderson reviewed the City's source of revenue for 1995 by category including taxes, state aid, licenses and permits, utility revenue, services and fines, interest and assessments, cemetery and miscellaneous. He then reviewed anticipated expenditures by department including administration, police, fire, public works, elections, planning and zoning, parks and recreation, city hall, cemetery, commissions, recycling, ambulance, local access and debt redemption fund.

It was noted that \$225,000.00 is set aside in park dedication fees for the purpose of rebuilding the Community Center.

Departments having balances at the end of 1994 will carry those balances over as capital outlay funds rather than as a carry-over into the general fund.

The Public Works Department will pay for 50% of the new truck from balances in the capital outlay fund. The remainder of the cost will be financed.

Mayor Anderson asked for comments or questions from the audience. Doris Fraser asked why administrative supplies was so much higher and was informed that the major increase was the newsletter expense.

MOTION 12S1-01-94 WAS MADE BY CHUCK MILLER AND SECONDED BY DEAN SWANSON TO ADJOURN THE TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING AT 7:34 P.M. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

A meeting was scheduled for Friday, December 16th at 12:00 noon to approve the levy and budget for 1995.
