

SPECIAL COUNCIL SESSION
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA
DECEMBER 16, 1994
12:00 P.M. CITY HALL

The Council for the City of Crosslake, Minnesota met in the Chambers of City Hall on Friday, December 16th, 1994. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Kurt Anderson, Chuck Miller, Dean Swanson and Jack Webster. Absent was Lyle Arends. Also present was City Clerk Arlene Buchite and one resident.

Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon stating that the purpose of the meeting was to approve the 1995 levy and budget.

The levy consists of \$434,281.00 for the general fund, \$49,372.00 for the debt redemption fund minus an excess of \$347.00 in Tax Increment Financing for a total levy of \$483,306.00.

MOTION 12S2-01-94 WAS MADE BY DEAN SWANSON AND SECONDED BY JACK WEBSTER TO APPROVE THE 1995 LEVY OF \$483,306.00 AND THE 1995 BUDGET FOR \$750,042.00. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

Jack Webster stated that any carry-over in capital funds for 1994 will be credited to the department involved and will not stay in the general fund.

MOTION 12S2-02-94 WAS MADE BY JACK WEBSTER AND SECONDED BY DEAN SWANSON TO ADJOURN THE MEETING AT 12:03 P.M. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

A special meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, December 21st at 10:00 A.M. to re-evaluate the bids on the City truck, to confirm the hiring of the Warming House/Ice Rink Attendant, to approve the contract with Bonestroo, Rosene, Anderlik and Associates for the Community Center, and to review the invoice received from Bonestroo, Rosene, Anderlik and Associates.
