

TRUTH IN TAXATION HEARING  
CITY OF CROSSLAKE MINNESOTA

DECEMBER 12, 1996

7:00 P.M. AT THE CROSSLAKE COMMUNITY CENTER

The Council for the City of Crosslake, Minnesota met in the Crosslake Community Center on Thursday, December 12, 1996 for the purpose of reviewing City budgets, expenditures and receipts. The following Councilmembers were present: Mayor Dave Kolesar, Raymond Smyth, Charles Miller and John Webster. Absent was Richard Upton. Also present were Mayor-elect Bob Scott and Councilmember-elect Donna Keiffer as well as 5 residents.

Mayor Kolesar began the presentation by saying that the law required a Truth in Taxation meeting. He presented a booklet that had been prepared to show the anticipated expenditures and receipts for 1997 as compared to 1996.

The question was asked if the recycling would continue and Mayor Kolesar stated he was not sure at this time because the County was unsure if the grants would continue. He stated that the City Council does not feel that the City should pay for recycling.

There were no further questions. The residents were informed that there would be a final meeting on December 18, 1996 to approve the levy and budgets. The meeting was closed at 7:15 p.m.
