DECEMBER 15, 1993

The Council for the City of Crosslake Minnesota met in a special council session on December 15, 1993. The following Councilmembers were present; Mayor Kurt Anderson, Lyle M. Arends, Charles Miller, Dean Swanson and Jack Webster. Also present was reporter Jean-Paul Hudon. There were no citizens present.

Mayor Anderson called this special meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. stating that the primary purpose for this meeting was to approve the the final levy for 1994. Mayor Anderson stated that he would like to keep the levy exactly what it was last year because the City is in good financial shape and a raise in the levy is not needed.
