

Crosslake City Council  
September 7, 1982 - 12:00 AM - SPECIAL MEETING

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Carol Coulter at 12:05 AM. A moment of silence was held in respect of the deceased Telephone Company Manager, Gary Fread and his family. Council members present were Andolshek, Anderson and Arends. Delmonico was not able to attend.

MOTION: By Arends and seconded by Anderson that the council accept the recommendation of the Telephone Commission that Helen Fraser be appointed as Interim Manager of the Telephone Company at a rate of \$10.00 an hour until a replacement is hired. The motion carried and the vote was unanimous with the exception of the absent member.

Arends stated that the Telephone Commission had voted to give a \$100. memorial to the family of Gary Fread. The mayor stated that she had ordered flowers to be delivered from the City Council to the funeral home.

MOTION: By Arends and seconded by Andolshek that the city give a memorial to the Fread Family of the difference in the salary to be paid by the Telephone Company which will be through the 5th and the city's share to be through the 15th. The motion carried and the vote was unanimous with the exception of the absent member. (The memorial from the city was \$790.)

MOTION: By Anderson and seconded by Andolshek that the meeting be adjourned. The motion carried and the meeting was adjourned at 12:14 A.M.
