





LEGAL NOTICES

ORDINANCE NUMBER 47
AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND
REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION
AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAILER
COACH PARKS AND ERECTION OF
NEW BUILDINGS WITHIN THE
VILLAGE

The Council of the Village of Crosslake hereby ordains:

1. That no trailer coach shall be operated or maintained in said Village without operators thereof having first procured a permit from said Village Council.
A trailer coach park as used herein shall mean any site, lot, field or tract of land upon which 2 or more occupied trailer coaches are housed.
2. It is further ordained that no building or other construction be erected or commenced without the owner or lessee of said property first having obtained a license or permit for such construction from the Village Council. This license shall not be required for the improvement of existing construction.

3. The fee for these permits shall be \$1.00.
4. Penalty: Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period of not to exceed ninety (90) days.


