Stone to maintain same
{50.00 Fifty dollars} to the Pettekow,
neches & Atwell roads, same to be
maintained by E. Pettekow.

\$15.00 on the T. Park road. to be maintained
by the Wrights

There was a bill presented to the board
by the St. Josephs Hospital. For the care
of Mrs. Sweeney. In as much
as Mrs. Sweeney was admitted to the
hospital without the consent of the board

The board disclaims any liability for the bill.

Had this been a case for the board.

The patient would have been sent to a trained Maternity Home. Which has cost the Town ship a price of 25.00 which is to cover all contingencies

The board then audited and passed the accumulated bills, which were paid.
