Tires

The cost to dispose of a tire is dependent upon size and whether the tire has a rim or without a rim. The County does not take tires from retailers.

Compost/Yard Waste

Yard waste includes garden wastes, leaves, lawn cuttings, and weeds. *Keep compost/yard waste separate from brush*

Brush

Brush includes limbs, branches, logs, vines and prunings. Stumps are handled separately and the fee is dependent on the size. This a free service to residents.

Commercial generators will be charged.

Electronics

Examples: Copiers, VCR/DVD players, stereos, computers. *Business Electronics are collected during two special events held each fall and spring. Please contact us for more information or to be added to our notification list.

Household Appliances

Examples: Freezers, dishwashers, dryers, ranges, microwaves

Mattresses

If mattresses are wet and dirty, they must be disposed into the Landfill. Disposal fees for a mattress are different for dry, clean, recycled mattresses and dirty, wet mattresses.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW):

Household hazardous wastes are products that can be an environmental or health hazard when stored or disposed of improperly. A product or substance is hazardous when it contains one or more of the following properties:
